The Gospel for the upcoming weekend liturgies for the Ascension of the Lord was read aloud and reflected on by each individual Council member. It was noted that the Ascension is celebrated in lieu of the 7<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter. Personal intercessions were prayed. We concluded Opening Prayer with collective participation in the Responsorial Psalm for the Ascension.

## **Social Concerns**

- A sign-up table for volunteer opportunities will be set up in the Church Gathering Area.
- Corrigan Krause has again generously stepped in as the Weekend's prime sponsor with twice the support they gave last year.
- Sponsorship opportunities for Parish families are under development to allow support at any level will be awarded an entry into a drawing. Support at a \$100 level will be awarded a t-shirt plus entry into a drawing. Particulars are yet to be finalized.
