In an effort to provide a secure environment for your child(ren) and the catechists teaching them during PSR Sundays, we offer one entry door, one exit door, a locked school and a secure space to meet your child at the conclusion of PSR. To help the REO keep everyone safe, please adhere to the following procedures on PSR Sundays.

Arrival

- We offer two sessions (8:30 and 10:00). Students are permitted in the school 15 minutes prior to the start of class. Please do not send them earlier.
- Class begins promptly at 8:30 and 10:00. Please do not send them late!
- Students <u>only</u> enter via the school double doors and proceed up the stairs.
- Kdg-2 meet their class in the hall outside the REO office at the designated colors \circ K Blue 1st Green 2nd Yellow
- Grades 3–8 may proceed to their classroom.
- Please do not attempt to enter via any other doors.
- Any student running late (especially the youngest) are met at the top of the stairs and taken to class by a high school office aide or REO staff. There is no need for a parent to escort them to class.

Dismissal

- We use the interior stairs leading downstairs to the Parish Center (PC).
- Kdg-2 are dismissed first, followed by grades 3-5 with 6-8 last.
- Kdg-2 are escorted by the catechist and classroom aid to the PC and to the designated colors.
- Please sign your Kdg-2 child out with the catechist.
- Older children my join their Kdg-2 siblings to meet parents.

Regarding students in Grades 3-8

- The REO offers the use of Parish Center as a safe and secure location to pick up all PSR children. If you decide to arrange another location to meet your older child (grades 3-8), that is your prerogative. However, all students leave via the PC. Do not direct them to leave via any other doors and consider their safety in the church parking lot.
- Older students may sign out their Kdg-2 siblings <u>ONLY</u> when a note is provided in the REO. Your request will be noted on the attendance roster and visible to the catechist. It is preferred only older (6th, 7th, 8th) students sign out siblings.

For Everyone

- To keep the building secure, no other doors are in use (Lakeview, the small rectory lot, etc).
- Catechists, student aides and students are instructed not to open door to the outside for any reason.
- There are security cameras in the REO monitoring all doors.
- If an emergency arises during the time your child(ren) are at PSR, please call the REO number. There is someone at the REO desk during PSR.
